When to Contact The Land Trust for Tennessee:

We encourage all landowners who own conserved property to contact us any time they have questions about their conservation easement. There are many activities that may require our input or approval, so please call us as soon as you begin considering any of these activities.



Access & Ownership

- Selling or transferring all or a portion of your property
- Changing any property boundary
- Changing the ownership structure of the property
- Installing utility lines or granting an easement for a utility line
- Granting a right-of-way (ROW) or other easement



Buildings & Construction

- Siting or building a new house
- Expanding or relocating an existing house
- Constructing a new barn or other agricultural structure
- Building or expanding any structure
- Installing or constructing energy producing structures
- Placing any temporary structure on the property
- Constructing a new driveway or road



Timber, Land and Water

- Harvesting timber
- Clearing trees for agricultural use
- Creating or updating a forest management plan
- Creating or enlarging ponds or otherwise altering water sources
